Development Update

2401 Wilson – Hyatt Place Hotel. Construction continues with walls being completed and interior work continuing. 2401 Wilson – BeaconCrest Homes. Foundations are being built for the four new homes on 16th Street behind the hotel. Completion is expected by the end of 2016.
